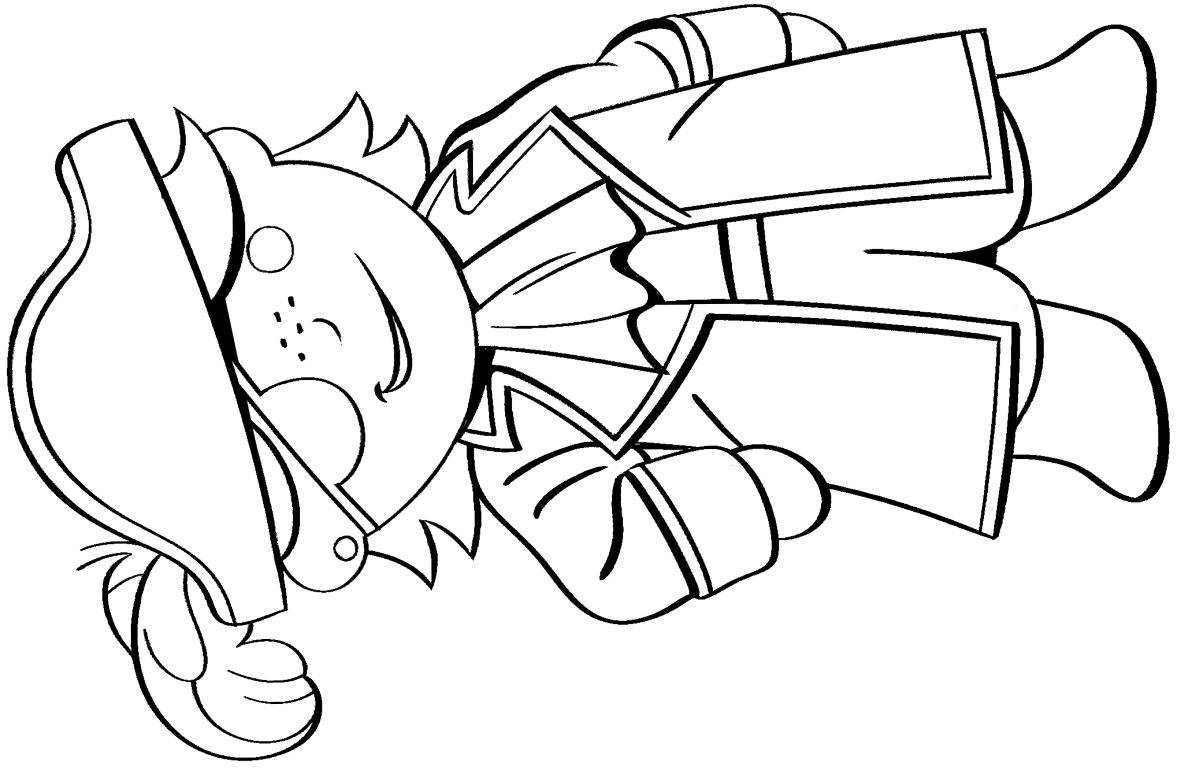

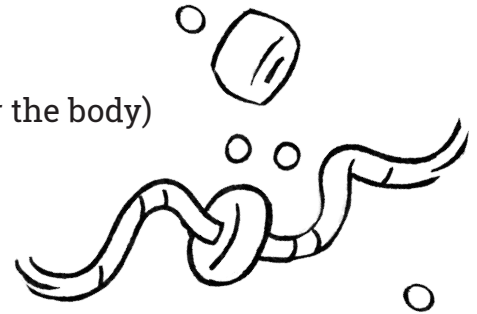
PERFORMING ARTS: PIPE CLEANER DOLLS

These cute pipe cleaner and bead dolls are easy to make and hours of fun to play with! Don't forget to give them names!

Supplies:

- Pipe cleaners
- Wooden beads (large ones for the head and smaller ones for the body)
- Black marker pen
- Straws
- Yarn



Instructions:

1. Wrap some yarn around your open palm to make a thick bundle, then remove the bundle of yarn from your hand. Keep the yarn looped.
2. Fold a pipe cleaner in half and trap the yarn in the middle twisting the pipe cleaner together to secure the yarn.
3. Thread the ends of the pipe cleaner through the large bead, pull the bead to the top trapping the yarn to make a head. Trim the looped ends of the yarn to your desired length to make the hair.
4. Add a small bead to make your dolls neck and bend the pipe cleaner ends out to make the arms.
5. Fold a second pipe cleaner in half and put it over one of the arms to make the body and legs.
6. Now add beads to make the body.
7. Add beads and straws to make the arms and legs. Fold the ends of the pipe cleaners over to secure the last beads.
